### HG suntan lotion stain remover

Suntan lotion or oil may cause yellow stains in fabrics. These stains cannot be removed with ordinary detergents or stain removers. HG "suntan lotion stain remover" is THE effective pre-treatment for removing such stains and is suitable for white and coloured fabrics.

**Directions for use:** Turn the nozzle on the front a quarter turn. Moisten the stains with warm water and then spray a liberal amount of liquid onto the stains from a distance of maximum 5 cm. Leave the product to absorb at least 1 hour without drying out. During the absorbing time, put the fabric in a clean plastic bucket and avoid contact with other materials/surfaces. Put the treated fabric in the washing machine and wash it as usual with the recommended amount of main detergent at max 60°C. Always comply with the care label. After washing do not tumble-dry the treated garment, but hang it on the washing line. Repeat the treatment if necessary. Turn the nozzle a quarter-turn after use (OFF).

**Attention:** Transport and store the bottle upright. Preferably use this product in a properly ventilated area or outside. Only use on colourfast fabrics, in case of doubt test the product in an inconspicuous place.

Avoid direct contact with metal elements (zips, buttons). If necessary, with thicker fabrics for example, spray the fabric on both sides for a more intensive treatment. Do not leave to absorb for longer than 2 hours and do not let it dry out. Do not dilute with water. The best result is achieved by washing the treated fabric separately from other laundry items. Using the tumble dryer may cause the stains to become permanent in the fabric.

Less effective for stains that have been there for a long time.
