

The HG "moisture absorber" brings back the relative humidity to an acceptable level in damp spaces. This prevents all adverse consequences of excess humidity, such as condensation, a stale smell, mildew, damp spots, vermin and wood rot.

The HG "moisture absorber" works on the basis of moisture-drawing granules. The system is silent and works without power or absorption surface than the often-used flakes and the round shape (with moisture) to flow along the granules. Together with the granule a moisture absorber that is faster, works longer and also extracts 1.5 times more moisture from the air than similar systems.

Depending on the relative humidity, an HG "moisture absorber" with 450 grams of HG moisture absorber granules will work for 2 to 3 months in a space of around 40 m³.

Throwing away the collected moisture is no longer a difficult task thanks to the handy jug. So no more spills and stains! The double-walled HG granule basket ensures that your hands do not touch the granules. Leaving you with clean hands at all times. Furthermore, filling the granule basket with the HG "moisture absorber" granules is very easy too.

The HG "moisture absorber" is suitable for in caravans, boats, sheds, cellars, closets or other spaces in your home. For instructions and other uses, please read the inside of this cardboard sleeve. **Transport and store the bottle upright.**

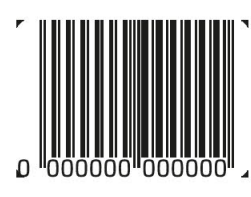

There can be many reasons for excess humidity in your caravan, boat, shed, cellar or other rooms in the house. This might be through poor ventilation, rising damp, disruption to air circulation as result of alterations, there is still construction damp in the walls, dampness, rain penetration, a defect in the cavity wall or cold air through insufficient heating (for instance during winter storage of your caravan or in the shed). Even the newest of homes can have damp problems because they are so well insulated allowing little chance of the damp to escape.

Moisture is produced through washing, showering, cooking etc. This surplus moisture manifests itself in many ways i.e. stale smells, steamed up windows, mould on walls, furniture and clothing, damp spots on stucco work, peeling paint, loose wallpaper or plasterwork, wood rot and even vermin such as wood lice and silverfish. Furthermore, in addition to the damage to material, damp is also bad for your health. The ideal relative humidity for man, animal and material is somewhere between 40% and 55%. The presence of moisture may allow some organisms to develop more easily. Dust mites and mould flourish if the relative humidity is higher than 70%. These dust mites and mould disperse irritating matter, called allergens. People with irritable airways can become allergic or oversensitive to these. In addition, it has been revealed that children living in a damp house have 25% more health problems (including respiratory complaints) than children living in a non-damp house. There is also a link between moisture and rheumatoid arthritis.

Your wallet also suffers from the damage of excess humidity. After all, warming up damp air is a more costly exercise than warming dry air, resulting in higher energy bills!

Good ventilation, a minimum temperature of around 16 degrees, restoring the disturbed air circulation or the defect in the cavity wall, hanging washing outside and similar measures can reduce the humidity in rooms. However, we cannot always control these factors; unheated winter storage for the caravan often occurs, as well as an unheated shed. The high degree of insulation in a home is beneficial for the heating costs, but restricts the removal of moisture from the air which is why we need to extract extra moisture from the rooms. With HG – the champion moisture absorber, it is now possible to do this faster, longer, easier and even more attractively!

The HG moisture absorber has been developed to beat all comparable systems on all fronts. And we have succeeded! For starters, the HG moisture absorber looks attractive and, therefore, is easy to fit in every interior. The round moisture-absorber granules used have a larger absorption surface than the often-used flakes. The round granule basket, designed for as much air contact as possible, this results in a moisture absorber that is faster, works longer and can also extract 1.5 times more moisture from the air than similar systems.

Throwing away the collected moisture is no longer a difficult task because of the handy jug. So no more spills and stains!

The double-walled HG granule basket ensures that your hands do not touch the granules. Leaving you with clean hands at all times. Furthermore, filling the granule basket with the HG moisture absorber granules refill is very easy too.

HG – the champion moisture absorber instructions:

1. Remove the lid from the granule basket.
2. Take the bottle out of the wrapper
3. Press the upturned bottom of the granule basket down and secure by clicking it into the basket.
4. Turn the lid off the bottle and remove the airtight seal, pour the granules out of the bottle into the granule basket.
5. Place the lid of the granule basket back on the basket and put the granule basket on the jug, then place HG "moisture absorber" in the room.

Attention: Check the granule basket once a month. If the granule basket is empty, empty the jug down the drain. To do this, take the granule basket off the jug, place it in the sink temporarily (take care not to spill any "trapped" moisture because it may stain), empty the jug and then replace the granule basket on the jug. Fill the granule basket with new granules and leave the HG moisture absorber to do its job! Carefully rinse the sink!

Tip: spill liquid may stain. If this is the case, clean the stain immediately with lots of water and dab carefully. Repeat if necessary. Any stains can be removed with sodium sulphate (available from the chemist). Make a 5% solution in water (50 grams p/l) and sprinkle it on the stain. Leave to work for around 30 minutes. Then allow the water to evaporate with a blow-drier or electric heater. Hoover up any remaining powder.

Avoid contact with leather and metal because these materials can be affected.
